Last month the Academy was visited for an assembly by Karen Hollett from Stonewall, the organisation set up by Ian Mckellen that supports and campaigns for LGBT rights (Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual or Transgender) and raises awareness of bullying or discrimination. Karen talked honestly about her experience of coming out as gay, how it changed her life, and the part we all play as a community in making LGBT+ individuals welcome and accepted. Karen was invited on the back of training that Mr Jones has attended with Stonewall which was in turn driven by Sixth Formers setting up a confidential safe space for pupils to relax and/or talk about questions, concerns or issues they may have about the LGBT+ community or being LGBT+ themselves. 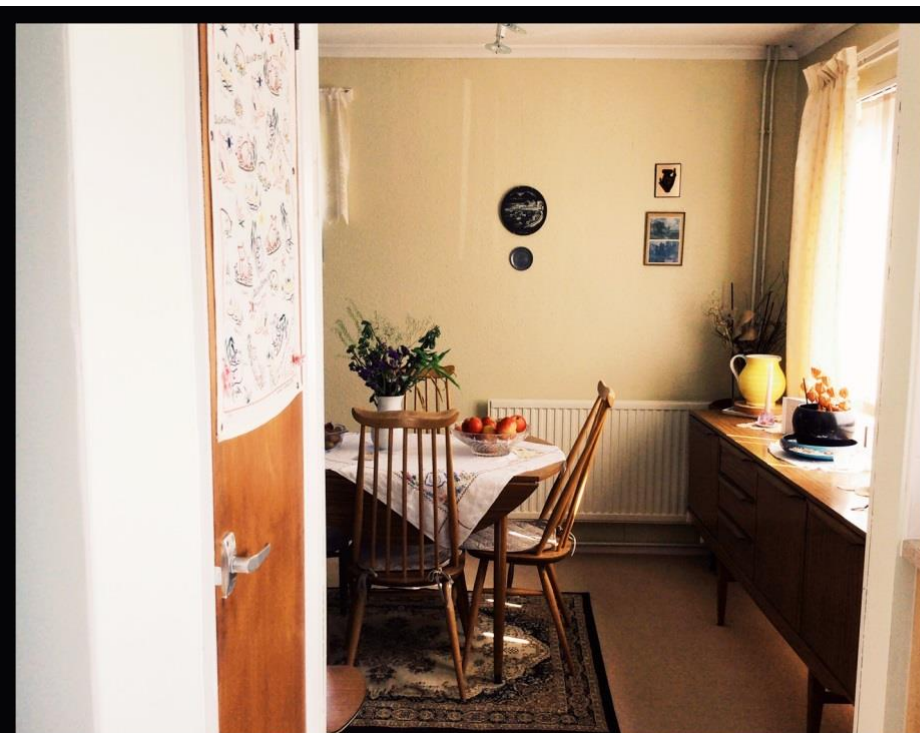
