


## Teaching Appointments

The Harnham Water Meadows Trust is holding a Heritage Crafts Open Day from 10am to 4.30pm on 18th May 2019 on the Water Meadows at our Education Centre, Rose Cottage, off the Harnham end of the Town Path in Salisbury. Entrance is free.

This is part of a Project funded by the Heritage Lottery Fund and Wiltshire Council Area Board. Crafts people will be demonstrating and explaining their crafts related to the South Wiltshire area and the water meadows. These will include thatching, hedge laying, hurdle making, scything, coppicing, pollarding, shearing sheep and sheep dog work, basket making, weaving and dyeing, lace making, beekeeping, and the tradition of herbal medicine. There will be displays about heavy horses, charcoal making and pottery of the area. Please go along.
